The Seeing-is-Believing Student

Learning is Enhanced by

- 1. taking notes and making lists to read later**
- 2. reading information to be learned**
- 3. learning from books, videotapes, filmstrips, printouts**
- 4. seeing a demonstration**

Studying and/or Reading Characteristics

- 1. reads for pleasure and relaxation**
- 2. can spend long periods of time studying**
- 3. requires quiet during study**
- 4. reads rapidly**
- 5. learns to spell words in configurations rather than phonetically**

School Challenges

- 1. having to do something before either seeing or reading about what needs to be done**
- 2. working in an environment with noise or movement**
- 3. tuning out sounds (not very responsive to music)**
- 4. listening to lectures without visual pictures or graphic to illustrate**
- 5. working in classrooms with no decorations and drab colors**
- 6. working under fluorescent lights (makes it hard to concentrate)**
