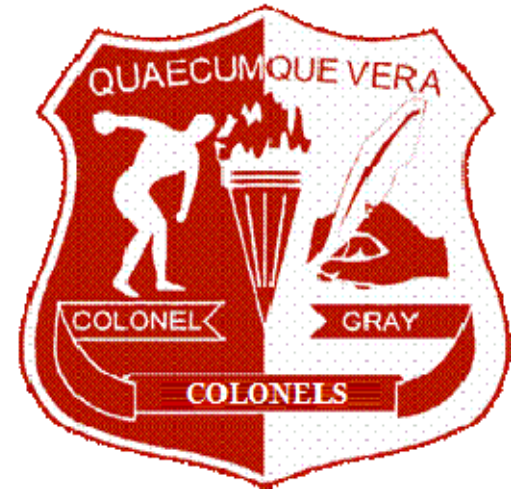

# WHAT IS THE COLONEL GRAY EDUCATION FOUNDATION INC.?

The Colonel Gray Education Foundation was established under provincial law in 1994. The Foundation mission statement is “to recognize and promote excellence in all aspects of life at Colonel Gray High School” by providing achievement awards, scholarships, and funding for special projects. A major task of the Foundation is to raise and administer funds in support of these goals. In the classroom, the workshops, the music and art studios and in extracurricular activities, students at Colonel Gray are doing extraordinary things. With the help of parents and teachers, and with the encouragement of their peers, students strive to do their best. The Foundation has a volunteer Board of Directors representing parents, students, teachers, friends, and graduates of Colonel Gray. The principal of the school is an ex-officio
