

Colonel Gray Exemption Policy

Revised Effective September 2011

To qualify for an exemption students must meet the following criteria:

1. Students must be enrolled in and complete four 110 hour credit courses in a semester.
2. To qualify for an exemption students must meet either of the following mark and attendance criteria below in all four courses:
 - a. no more than 6 absences and a minimum grade of 65% or
 - b. no more than 12 absences and a minimum grade of 80%.

- An absence has been defined by the Student Records Management Steering Committee as anytime a student misses more than 50% of the scheduled class time.
- The following absences are considered excused in determining exempt status. All other absences will be used to determine the total number of days absent during the semester.

AC – Absence Curricular – Activities directly associated with the curriculum where the full class is expected to participate.

AA – Absence Approved School - absences approved by admin, meetings with counselors, youth workers, etc. In rare cases, an absence may be coded as AA by the administration to allow a student to participate in an event when the student has been absent due to a high level of involvement in school based extra-curricular activities.

3. Students must have completed all course work and assessments as assigned by their four subject teachers.
4. Student behavior must meet the expectations of their teachers, school (Code of Conduct), school board (Caring Places to Learn Policy, etc.), and the School Act. Administration reserves the right to veto an exemption if the behavior of the student is not acceptable.
5. Students must write a least one exam each semester
6. Students may exempt a maximum of 2 exams per semester
