- **Students who receive scholarship offers are asked to advise Student Services so that this can be acknowledged at graduation. Only ACCEPTED offers will be acknowledged. Only one will be read.**

Apply before the March 1st deadline (85%)**

**Note: A high average doesn't always mean entrance into some universities. For example, Queens University is approx. 89%**

***U.P.E.I admission requirements for Arts,  
Business and Science:***

**Arts: English, one Social Studies or Language, and any three other academic courses, Grade 12 Math recommended. Note: Grade 12 Math is a prerequisite for some first year Arts courses (check with U.P.E.I)**

**Business: English, Mathematics, any two Social Studies, Languages or Sciences, and one other academic course**

**Science: English, Mathematics, two Sciences and one other academic course. If Grade 12 Chemistry is not selected to meet the Science requirement, Grade 11 Chemistry is required**

**Note: There are new programs such as Kinesiology at U.P.E.I in 2011/12**

## ***Holland College***

### ***Admission***

**Requirements and program length vary.**

**For example: Police Science Cadet - 35 weeks  
You must be 19 years old, General Program or above.**

**Architectural Technology - 2 years  
Academic Grade 12 or equivalent - 65% in English, Math,  
and Physics (grade 11 also excepted).**
