However, you must check with the Program Director if you plan to visit during the week. Visitors are also subject to camp policy while on the property.

MEDICATION AND DRUG POLICY

The use of alcohol, tobacco, or illicit drugs is strictly prohibited!

At the time of registration, the Camp nurse or designated health worker must be made aware of and given all medication and prescriptions, for the safety of all campers. Thank you for complying with these terms!

DRESS CODE

The Camp wishes to promote an atmosphere of respect. Campers and staff are expected to wear appropriate clothing at Camp. Clothing that will be considered inappropriate includes spaghetti straps, halter tops, short shorts, and tube tops. Camp clothing must NOT depict messages, whether written or picture form, which are profane, demeaning or promote illegal or immoral activity or promote the use of alcohol or drugs. This dress code will be strictly adhered to. The Program Director reserves the right to define the term "inappropriate". Campers and staff who do not comply will be required to change into appropriate clothing.

POLICY REGARDING CAMPERS AS VOLUNTEERS
