## creative drama camp

**AUGUST 9 – 13** for AGES 9 & UP

How does a play get from page to stage? This program is designed to encourage creativity. Students will write their own play and bring it to life on stage. Using an innovative collaborative process, the class will write, cast, direct, rehearse and finally perform their play. No acting experience is required, just a creative spirit and a desire to perform on stage. The purpose of this program is to foster communication, collaboration and confidence using acting exercise, movement, voice, writing and imagination.
