## After School Program

The Murphy's Community Centre is presently registering children for our After School program for the upcoming school year 200/11.

Currently Prince Street & St. Jean Elementary School are the only locations we will be providing a pick-up and drop-off service. Children who are bused from Spring Park and Lecole Francois-Buote Schools are met at their designated bus stops and escorted to the Centre by School Age Staff. We are currently looking into providing this same arrangement for West Kent School.

Children attending other schools can attend the program, but alternative arrangements would need to be discussed with our School Age Program Manager, Patrick MacDonald.

We offer full-day programs (7:30 am-6 pm) during Parent/Teacher Interview Days, Professional Development Days and Storm Days.
