School Update

Coles Associates Ltd. has been engaged by the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal to complete an investigation at Morell Consolidated School. Investigation of the exterior building foundation, drainage, walls, windows and roof has been completed. Coles Associates Ltd. will provide an estimate of the cost for repairs and upgrades to address the water infiltration problems, as well as an upgrade of the ventilation system by February 21. The Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal will then review the estimates and submit a report to the Department of Education and Early Childhood Development by early March. It is expected that the Eastern School District will receive direction by the end of March.
