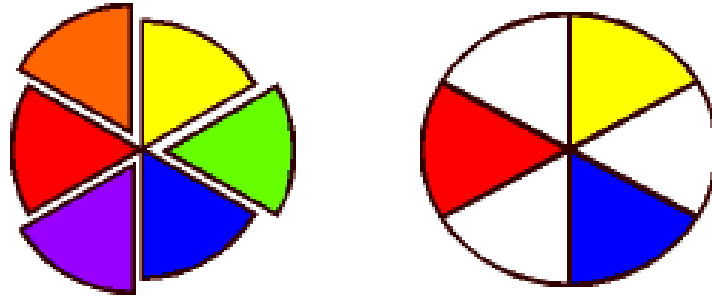


Color Wheels

The Color Wheel is a chart that shows how colors are related and sorted to make it easier to mix the right colors for paint/ink.



- **Primary** colors are RED, YELLOW, and BLUE. They can not be made by mixing other colors.
- **Secondary** colors are green, orange, and purple. They are made by mixing two primaries.
- **Tertiary** colors are red-orange, yellow-orange, blue-green, blue-purple, red-purple, yellow-green. They are made by mixing one primary and one secondary.
- **Complimentary** (contrasting or opposite) colors are colors opposite on the color wheel (Red/Green, blue/orange, purple/yellow)
- **Analogous** colors are colors that are side-by-side on the color wheel. They tend to look good together.
- **Warm** colors are red, orange, yellow. They increase temperature, create warmth, signifies fire or hear.
- **Cool** colors are blue, purple and sometimes green. They decrease temperature, cool down images, signifies ice, water, cold.
- **Neutral** colors are brown, grey, beige, etc. They are colors with no strong differentiations.
- When naming colors, always place the primary color first (red-yellow, blue-green, yellow-orange)
