Two Ways to Quickly Get Info: Using Students Achieve, there are many ways to access various types of information about your children and school. In these instructions we will learn two ways to easily access information about academic performance. The first way gives more detail while the second way is faster.

Normally teacher's names are displayed here. They have simply been obscured in this image for privacy reasons.

First Way: 1. Click on the Course Mark or the "Three Dots" to access marks for that course. Depending on which teachers have chosen to display courses online, there will be one to several courses listed here. Whether you see a mark displayed or three dots is controlled from the school.
