To alleviate forgetting the payments, we strongly encourage parents to pay by paypal. This saves sending money to school with your child and makes it much quicker for the order to be processed by the volunteers. If you use paypal, please allow a couple of days for the payments to be processed. If the paypal transaction is not complete, your account will continue to show up on the unpaid list until it is processed.

Our school strives to keep these students safe in the school environment including school busses. It is necessary to check all ingredient labels to see if the products contain peanuts/nuts. Please do not send these products to school or on field trips at any time. Also we do not allow WOW butter in the school so please do not send this with your child. We appreciate the home and school working together to provide a safe place for all our students. Thank you for your cooperation.
