Code of Conduct for Interscholastic Athletes

It is a privilege to be selected as a member of a Souris Regional High School athletic team. Students who participate in extra-curricular activities should be take pride in representing the school and are expected to be good ambassadors.

- ▶ Respect is to be shown for coaches, officials, opponents, spectators, and yourself. Good sportsmanship is to be exhibited at all times.
- ▶ Membership on a team is dependent upon good attitude, consistent work habits, regular class attendance, and satisfactory academic performance.
- ▶ Commitment to the team is to be shown by attendance at all practises, games, and team meetings. In cases where it is impossible to be in attendance due to sickness, injury, or another valid reason, the coach should be notified beforehand.
- ▶ Foul language, smoking, drinking, or drug use will not be tolerated.
- ▶ Eastern School District participation forms and school sport fees are to be turned in to the SRHS athletic department.
- ▶ An SRHS Athletic Leave form is to be signed by a teacher whose class will missed, due to the team leaving early for a game. This form is to be delivered to the teacher at least one day in advance of the game. Athletes are responsible for all work covered and any assignments given during the missed class.
- ▶ Quitting the team once the season has begun risks your chance of trying out for other SRHS teams during the year.
- ▶ Athletes who have been suspended or who are absent from school without approval will not be allowed to play on that day.
- ▶ Athletes are to realize that equal playing time is not guaranteed for all players. Before the season begins athletes and coaches should discuss expectations for the season.
- ▶ Athletes are to travel with the team on the bus provided by the school. Other travel arrangements will be permitted only in exceptional circumstances, with prior written permission from parents and approval by the school administration. No food or drinks are allowed on any Souris High buses. Misbehaviour on a bus may result in expulsion from the team.
- ▶ Uniforms are the property of the school, to be worn only during games, washed after each game, and turned in to the coach or a member of the athletic department immediately after the end of the season.
