Frequently Asked Questions

1. How do I report my child as absent?

A: Please write a note before the absence, when possible, and your child can submit it to their homeroom teacher. If your student is sick, you can phone the Main Office at 687-7130 to report their illness. If for some reason you can not make that contact on the day prior or the day of the absence, then you can send a note to school on the following day when your child returns to class.

2. What are the procedures to be followed when visiting the school?

A: Please report to the Main Office where Lori can direct your inquiry and provide you with a Visitor's ID tag.

3. How do I volunteer at SRHS?

A: There are different areas of school life which require the input of volunteers:

- a. Breakfast Program: parents can contact Mary Paquet, Coordinator, at 687-2331.
- b. Sports: if you can help with coaching, transportation, or supervision of students involved in a sport, then please call 687-7130 and speak with Shane MacClure.
- c. If you have a particular skill or are available as a guest speaker, please register your area of expertise with Lori Sanderson at 687-7130 as we are creating a "Skills Database" of our local talent.

4. How do I contact classroom teachers?

A: There are several ways to contact your child's classroom teacher, and this contact is strongly encouraged as it provides important support and communication to both home and school:

- d. Attend Parent/Teacher Interviews .
