

Note from Ms. Cooper, the History professor:

I am totally flexible with due dates.

Perhaps you should set weeks as due dates - as in, assignments are due by Friday of the week of Feb 14th ... this will allow students to work at their own pace a bit more. Alternatively, your list of due dates seems fine too.

As for citing sources on the Virtual High School pages using the MLA format. If there is no author, they can cite the article title, VHS, online (title, VHS, online) as an in-text citation for quotes and specific references.

In the works cited list at the end of assignments, they should try to identify the source a bit more (i.e. if it's from the Canadian encyclopedia, or Wikipedia etc)

Samples can look like this:

Author, article title. Canadian encyclopedia. Virtual High School url, date accessed.

Article title, Virtual High School url, date accessed.

Please do not have students use my name as I'm not the course author. The author is listed as Virtual High School since the course was developed by a team of people. Students can also use this information when citing the VHS sources.

2011 can be used as the date.
