

ITC 401 - Art Assignment

A-value: Use the Paint program to design 2 or more original pieces of artwork.
OR
Use Paint Shop Pro - Animation Shop to design 2 original animated gif's.

B-value: Use pre-made designs from Paint Shop Pro, SRHS art, clip art, or the Internet.
Combine the figures to form new scenes or cartoons.
Where necessary, resize or recolor the figures.

Ideas for your Artwork Use your own creativity.

Check designs of former SRHS students.

Bring cartoon, magazine, or logo images to class
so you can copy the designs to computer.

Saving Type *your name*
2009/10 somewhere on each piece of artwork before making the final save.

Save the pictures in a folder named ART on your g: drive
Filenames for your designs should describe the pictures.

Print-Out Use a word processor to do the following:

1. List the exact names of your designs so Mr. MacClure can find them quickly.
2. A-value designs: Type a paragraph briefly describing the method you used to create your original designs.
B-value designs: Type a paragraph briefly describing where you found the figures for your artwork and how you moved, combined, and changed them to form the new scenes.
3. Save this WP file in the ART folder with the name *artwork*.
4. Print the file and hand it in to Mr. MacClure.

DO NOT print your pictures. It uses too much ink .

Marking Scale out of 20 for each painting:

A + = 20

A = 19

A - = 18

B + = 17

B = 16

B - = 15

C + = 14

C = 13

C - = 12

D + = 11

D = 10

D - = 8

E = 4

0 = 0

Penalties:

If you do not hand in an explanation print-out, you automatically lose 5 out of the 40 marks.

If you do not type your name and year on each piece of art, you lose 2 out of the 40 marks.

Copying a previously designed piece or SRHS artwork, making minimal modifications, and claiming it as your own will result in a loss of 40 out of 40 marks.

Bonus:

Bonus marks may be given for doing extra pieces of artwork, up to a maximum of 40 out of 40 marks.
