

MicroSoft PowerPoint Slide Show

Create a slide show on a topic of interest to you.
Before starting, get approval of your topic from Mr. MacClure.

Some topic ideas:

- Presentation of your favourite sports team or music group
- Summary of a movie you have seen
- Plan for a trip you would like to take
- Comparison of different types of cars, footwear, or clothing
- A day in the life of a typical or non-atypical SRHS student
- Menu for a restaurant
- Lists and details of chores which you have to do soon
- How to get ready for a game or a date
- Chart and description of your family, team, or friends

Include:

- ▶ 8 or more frames
- ▶ lots of pictures (.jpg) downloaded from the Internet or from your own collection
- ▶ a background design and a different layout
- ▶ good use of font, size, colour, and other features with your words
- ▶ use of Title & Text boxes and Word Art in some slides
- ▶ a bulleted list - change its properties
- ▶ a data chart or a table - include colours and formatted numerical data
- ▶ enter some different Shapes
- ▶ use the Insert option to insert the date on the first or last slide (or on all slides)
- ▶ at least one picture from your own art work or a scanned piece of art work
- ▶ use of 3 or 4 types of slide transitions or animations
- ▶ automatic slide advance, with a suitable delay for each slide
- ▶ music playing in the background (.mp3's are good) throughout all or part of the show (make sure that this music file is first saved in the same folder as your slide show)
- ▶ a .wav sound (like clapping or thunder) on at least one slide
- ▶ some other feature or features which you have discovered yourself (i.e.: timed bullets, web links, video clips)

Save your project with an appropriate name in a **Power Point** sub-folder inside your **ITC** folder
